How can I receive government-subsidised aged care services?

If you are over 65 you can apply for government-subsidised aged care services by contacting <u>My Aged Care</u> by phone or online to discuss your care needs.



The assessor can forward a referral to your preferred provider (eg. Glasshouse Country Care) who will then contact you if they have capacity for that service.

Or you can search for a provider yourself.

If you choose to do this, your assessor will give you a referral code (eg. 2-12345678912) for each service you are eligible for to give to the provider of your choice. These referral codes are listed in your support plan.

You may not be able to receive services straight away as providers do not always have the capacity to take new clients.

You are welcome to contact other providers to check if they have availability for the services you need. Once a service provider has accepted the referral, they will contact you. You can ask questions and make sure you understand any fees and your client contribution before you agree to services.

The provider will then prepare the paperwork for signing. Once that is signed by you and returned, you can start receiving services.
